



Guild of St Botolph's

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Guild of St Botolph's is administered by the Parish of Boston under the Boston Stump Restoration Trust and Friends of St Botolph's Church
2. Should you bring the Guild of St Botolph's into disrepute you will be asked to forfeit your membership and will not be able to apply for membership for a set period of time.
3. You have a right to appeal the decision made, this should be done within 10 working days in writing to Guild of St Botolph's, Rectory Offices, Wormgate, Boston PE21 6NP. It should state why you are appealing the decision, we will respond in 30 working days of receipt.
4. The Guild of St Botolph's has the right to withdraw any benefit at any time with good reason, this will be communicated to you within 30 working days.
5. Any complaints should be forwarded in writing to The Guild of St Botolph's, The Rectory Offices, Wormgate, Boston. PE21 6NP. We will respond in 30 working days of receipt of the correspondence.
6. Only the member signed up to the Guild of St Botolph's may use the benefits associated. We reserve the right to ask for identification.
7. Many of the benefits provided by being a member of the Guild of St Botolph's are provided by the Parochial Church Council [PCC] of the Parish of Boston and therefore fall under the governance and rules of the PCC.

Tower Tickets

1. Two free tickets per month can be obtained via the Boston Stump Gift Shop. You should present your valid membership card.
2. Under 18's should be accompanied by someone over the age of 18.
3. You must complete the registration process before climbing.
4. We reserve the right to refuse anyone access at any time.
5. The opening times of the tower are Monday – Saturday, 10am – 3.30pm & Sunday 1.30pm – 3.30pm.
6. Due to adverse weather conditions it is not always safe to allow people to climb the tower, please check our social media for updates or call the Church Office if you are unsure.

Regular Updates & Invitations

1. This entitles you to regular updates and invitations sent out via email on developments, activities and events taking place at St Botolph's.
2. The Parish Magazine is published bi-monthly and you will be entitled to one copy, per household, being sent via mail to the address given on your application form.

Guild of St Botolph's Badge

1. 10% discount will be given on all items sold via our Gift Shop or Coffee Shop when presenting the Guild Badge and valid membership card.
2. From time to time, some items may not be included in this deal, they will be clearly marked.
3. 10% discount only applies to products sold in our Gift Shop and Coffee Shop and not on any other service offered in the Parish of Boston.

Discounts on selected Events and Concerts

1. This does not include all Events and Concerts, those eligible for special discounts will be clearly marked with the particular discount applicable included.
2. Tickets should be bought via telephone or the Gift Shop. Please present your valid membership card to apply the discount when purchasing your ticket.

A Pair of Free tickets to a St Botolph's Music Event

1. You are eligible to 2 free tickets per calendar year.
2. This includes any concert or event which is being held by St Botolph's Church.
3. This excludes all events which are being organised by external agents.
4. Events eligible for free tickets will be advertised as so.

High Tea at St Botolph's for 4 People

1. With this benefit you and 3 guests are entitled to a free High Tea in St Botolph's Church Coffee Shop, once per calendar year.
2. 7 days' notice is required.
3. Under 18's will be offered suitable soft drinks in lieu of alcoholic drinks. Alcoholic drinks will only be served to those who are 18 or over. We have the right to ask anyone for identification to prove age.
4. Any food allergies or intolerances should be noted when booking.
5. More people can be added to your booking for an extra charge, please speak to the office for more information when booking your High Tea.

Private Tour of St Botolph's

1. This benefit includes you and 5 other guests as part of a guided tour.
2. You are entitled to one tour per calendar year.
3. Evening Tours can be arranged, these may carry an extra charge, please speak to the office when booking your tour.
4. More people can be added to your booking for an extra charge per head, please speak to the office when booking your tour for more information.

Use of the Cotton Chapel (with or without catering)

1. This benefit gives you the right to use the Cotton Chapel, to the west end of St Botolph's for a function of your choice once a calendar year.
2. The Guild has the right to refuse anyone use of the Cotton Chapel should the event proposed be outside the ethos and morals of a place of worship as set out by the PCC of the Parish of Boston.
3. Use of the Cotton Chapel (without catering) should be booked 30 working days before the intended time of use.
4. Use of the Cotton Chapel (with catering) should be booked at least 60 working days prior to the intended time of use, please note that a confirmation of catering numbers and dietary requirements should be submitted 2 weeks prior to intended use.
5. All services and pre-arranged events/activities planned to take place in the Cotton Chapel will have precedence. We reserve the right to rearrange events should the Chapel be required
6. The Chapel is a place of worship and as such, you are required to treat the space with respect. We reserve the right to refuse all future bookings should this be disrespected.

Use of the Nave of St Botolph's

1. You are eligible to use the Nave of St Botolph's Church once a calendar year.
2. The Guild has the right to refuse anyone use of the Nave should the event proposed be outside the ethos and morals of a place of worship as set out by the PCC of the Parish of Boston.
3. Use of the Nave should be booked 30 working days before the intended time of use.
4. Private events can be held from 4pm Monday – Saturday until midnight.
5. Should you require the Nave during the day, please contact the Parish Office – this may carry a further charge.
6. All services and pre-arranged events/activities planned to take place in the Nave will have precedence. We reserve the right to rearrange events should the Nave be required.

NB: A calendar year runs from January through to December, and events applicable to this restriction cannot be carried over to future years.
